

# Expedited Timeline

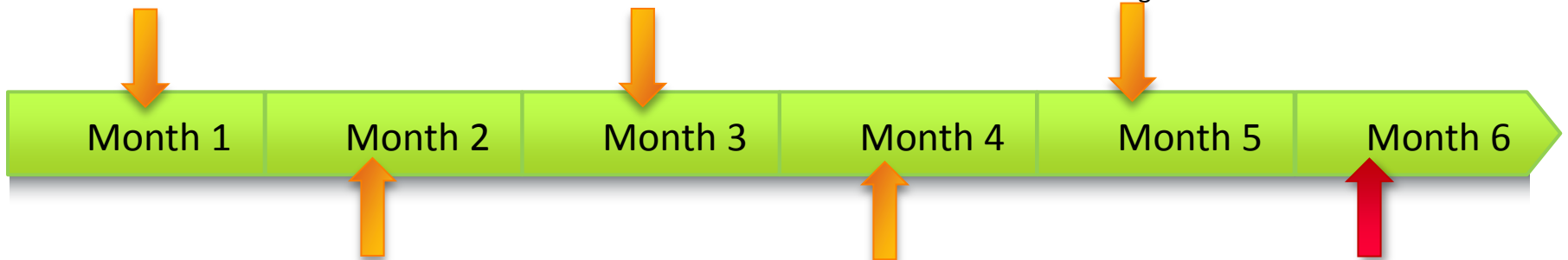
**Workshop Planning** Each workshop includes a series of 2 preparation calls to confirm goals, question selection, and define teaching strategy.

## **Writing Group Completion & Editorial Process**

The writing groups get together to finish their draft, refine statistics, and format references; the draft is submitted.

## **Faculty/Resident Mentoring**

By creating a structured plan for mentoring sessions, protected time, and FPIN Institute online module assignments; the residents begin to learn EBM!



## **Faculty Preparation & Workshop**

Materials are provided to introduce the faculty “what to expect”, opportunities are given to participate in literature searching, and the workshop is conducted culminating in a 50%complete first-draft.

## **Pub Que & Resident Launch**

After 3-6 rounds (on average) of editorial review the manuscript will be approved at which point the system can be replicated for the residents.

## **Resident Publication**

By using a writing workshop to launch FPIN, programs typically begin to see resident publications within 6 months.

Programs that use FPIN’s Onsite Workshops as their initial implementation strategy yield faster results by alleviating the self-study pitfalls & learning curve.
