



National FPIN Leader Discount

1. What is the National FPIN Leader Discount?

The National FPIN Leader Discount is an opportunity for faculty to participate in furthering FPIN's mission through tangible activities and get involved in a rewarding faculty development endeavor while earning a discount for their organization. FPIN will match the faculty skill set with the needs of the organization to create a win-win.

2. Who can participate?

Programs that have been with FPIN for 2+ years are eligible to apply.

3. How much time is involved?

A 24-hour annual commitment is required and may be filled in a variety of ways.

4. Who is eligible to become a National FPIN Leader?

The National FPIN Leader must be an interested faculty member who has published at least one FPIN project or has a proven track record of leadership.

5. How much is the discount?

Once a formal agreement is in place, FPIN will grant the organization a **10% discount** for their program's membership fees.

6. What types of opportunities are available?

While many more may be available, some examples include curriculum development for the FPIN Institute, editing, and task force initiatives.

7. How do I apply for the National FPIN Leader Discount?

Meetings must be scheduled by **June 15, 2017**. All consultation calls and a formal agreement must be in place by **July 15, 2017**.
